Time, Date and Location:

The course will be held at the Mallala Motor Sport Park on Saturday 30th May, 2015 from 8.00am to 5.00pm.

Eligibility:

All drivers must hold a minimum of a L2S/J licence and current Drivers Licence or Permit. L or P Plates must be displayed where appropriate.

Entries:

Entries will open upon the publication of these Supplementary Regulations, with a maximum of 40 will be accepted. On the 22nd May, 2015. The first 40, PAID entries will be accepted. Entries may be refused in accordance with NCR 83 of the current CAMS Manual of Motor Sport.

Fees:

Entry fees for this event will be \$175.00 per person for club members and any member of an MSCA affiliated club and \$180 for any other person, payable on nomination. Payment to be made by cash or cheque.

Please make all cheques payable to AROCA SA. Credit card facilities ARE NOT available.

General Supplementary Regulations Cont..

Refunds:

Refunds will not be granted after the closing of entries on Friday 22nd May, 2015 unless a replacement entry can be found, prior arrangements have been made with the organisers or on cancellation of the event.

Scrutineering:

All vehicles must be presented to the Scrutineering Bay between the hours of 8.00am and 8.45am. Vehicles will be scrutineered by MSCA scrutineers. All vehicles must comply with Schedules A & B of the General Requirements for Cars and Drivers of the current CAMS Manual of Motor Sport. Vehicles must be adequately muffled to comply with noise restrictions.

Licenses:

All competitors must hold a current Drivers Licence or Permit and L and P plates must be displayed where necessary. All instructors will hold a minimum of a CAMS L2S license. All participants must sign the Passenger in Vehicles disclaimer. CAMS Licence, Club Membership and if issued, CAMS Vehicle Logbook must be presented at documentation.

Briefing:

Drivers briefing will be held at the Scrutineering bay at 9.00am. All drivers and officials must attend.

The Event:

THIS EVENT IS A SKILLS ENHANCEMENT DAY NOT A TRACK DAY!!

The Driver Skills course will consist of various low speed exercises involving instruction on braking techniques, accident avoidance and emergency procedures sessions. These exercises will be followed by parade laps (in accordance with NCR 20a) around the complete circuit of the track under the control of the Course Car. AT NORMAL SPEED, with an in-car instructor who will point out braking points and apexes etc. All drivers MUST obey the in-car instructor at all times. Helmets ARE NOT required for this part of the day.

Apparel:

Approved driving suits or long trousers with long sleeve shirts made of cotton or wool must be worn. Driving boots or sensible enclosed shoes must be worn. Bring a hat and sun block cream. All participant apparel shall be in accordance with Schedule D of the CAMS Manual of Motor Sport.

Awards:

No awards or trophies will be presented.

Cancellation or Postponement:

The Organisers reserve the right to alter or abandon the Event in accordance with NCR 59 or if the number of entries received by the closing date is, in their opinion, insufficient; or to alter or abandon the Event if any part of the course is rendered impassable.

Fuel:

Fuel will not be available at the track and fuel is restricted to "Commercial Fuel" which must comply with Schedule G of the current CAMS Manual of Motor Sport. Leaded racing fuel is permissible as per Schedule G of the current CAMS Manual of Motor Sport Part 3.

Alcohol, Drugs and Other Substances:

Any holder of a CAMS 'Competition' or 'Officials' licence (or equivalent licence issued by another ASN) may be tested for the presence of drugs (or other banned substances) and subject to a penalty(ies) for a breach in accordance with the CAMS Anti-Doping Policy and/or the CAMS Illicit Drugs in Sport (Safety Testing) Policy as published on the CAMS website. Consumption of alcohol in the paddock, pits or any section of the competition venue/course under the control of the Officials is forbidden until all competition is concluded each day. Accordingly, any holder of a CAMS 'Competition' or 'Officials' licence (or equivalent licence issued by another ASN) may also be tested for the presence of alcohol by a CAMS Accredited Testing Official (CATO) in accordance with the CAMS Standard Operating Procedure for Breath Alcohol Testing.

Exclusion:

The Clerk of Course for the meeting may exclude from any further participation, any entrant who:

- a. Breaches the guidelines laid down within these Supplementary Regulations.
- b. Drives in a manner that may endanger themselves or another entrant/official, or
- c. Disobeys any official.

General Supplementary Regulations Cont.

Catering:

A lunch box will be provided as part of your entry fee. The canteen availability TBA.

Children:

Parents and/or guardians have the responsibility of maintaining control of their children for the duration of the event. Children under the age of 16 years are not permitted in the pitlane area at any time during the event.

Cancellation:

The organisers reserve the right to cancel the event due to extreme weather conditions or any other unforeseen circumstance.

Protests:

Any protests shall be lodged in accordance with Part XII of the NCR.
